While the open market with its supply contracts has led to a greater focus on availability and performance of the installed assets, much of the utility industry's installed capacity is old, leading to questions about reliability. To maximise the business value of these assets, the company must ensure availability, safety, and environmental care; hence, the need for processes using asset risk management.
