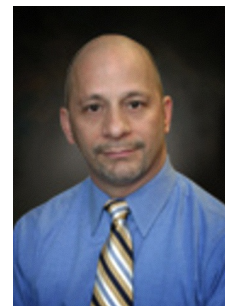

## KEYNOTE ADDRESS – Smart Grid: A Workforce GAME CHANGER



Wanda Reder, Vice President of the Power Systems Services Division at S&C Electric Company, will present this year's keynote address at the International Conference of Doble Clients.

The field of power and energy is facing a crucial challenge. Baby boomers will soon begin retiring in huge numbers creating an impending shortage. To compound the situation, our workforce is the linchpin behind monumental advancements to support Smart Grid and renewable energy deployment. This presentation will discuss the forecasted engineering workforce attrition, the competencies that are emerging for grid modernization, and actions required to develop a sufficient pipeline for current and future technical talent needs.

Wanda is the Immediate Past-President of the IEEE Power & Energy Society and has served on the Governing Board since 2002. Wanda is the Chair for IEEE's Smart Grid efforts and is on the IEEE Women In Engineering Governing Committee.

She has been researching, publishing and presenting on the topic of the maturing power industry workforce as well as the challenge to attract and educate the necessary talent for the industry. Her efforts have resulted in the creation of the IEEE Power & Energy Engineering Collaborative which serves to bolster the industry image, increase outreach efforts, rebuild power related curriculums, and transfer necessary knowledge in order to develop the talent to address future industry challenges.

As Vice President of the Power Systems Services Division at S&C Electric Company, Wanda oversees engineering, field service, and project management capabilities to utilities, developers and industrial customers through the US and Canada. Prior to S&C, Wanda held numerous leadership positions at Exelon and Northern States Power (now Xcel) where she was responsible for asset investment strategy, standards, engineering, system planning, reliability and work management, unregulated business start-ups, distribution automation, automated meter reading, development of conservation, and load management initiatives.
